Editorial

The Holy Qur'an is a unique book of Divine guidance. It is not in itself a book of science, but rather, a book of signs. It contains more than 6000 signs, of which over 1000 deal with science, technology, and medical matters. Many of the verses dealing with signs record scientific and medical knowledge that modern science and medicine is only just discovering - 1400 years after the revelation of the Qur'an.

The Qur'an includes subjects as diverse as astronomy, biology, botany, genetics, physics, and earth science, with some stunningly advanced insights into the workings of nature that have only recently been confirmed by scientific research. In each case there is not long and detailed scientific information, but rather, a short summary of facts.

The expansion of the Universe, which is referred to in Qur'an 51:47, is the most imposing discovery of modern science. It is a firmly established concept, and the only debate centers around the way this is taking place. It was first suggested by the general theory of relativity and is backed up by physics in the examination of the galactic spectrum. Last April, scientists used a revolutionary new camera to obtain a snapshot of a young star, about 1,320 trillion miles from Earth in the constellation Centaurus, just starting its



Software for calculating the beginning of lunar months

Islamic months start at sunset on the day of visual sighting of the lunar crescent. Some Muslim scholars hold the view that visual sighting is necessary to determine the start of a month. It is, however, useful to accurately predict when a crescent is likely to be visible in order to produce lunar calendars in advance. A computer program entitled "MoonCalc version 4.0" has been developed by Dr. Monzur Ahmed of Birmingham, United Kingdom to search the world locations which satisfy several visibility criteria for sighting the lunar crescent. The program provides world maps for the start of each lunar month, showing areas where the crescent is likely to be first sighted (see the bottom figure on this page for the start of Rabi' II, 1419 - July 24/25, 1998 - the different colored bands represent the age of the moon at sunset on the day of predicted sighting). Wahy (Inspiration)



The Arabic word Wahy refers to secret inspiration, or hidden

information, اعلام بخفاء which is passed from the giver (the one who inspires) to the receiver (the one who is inspired with). The word wahy and its derivatives have been repeated seventy-eight times in the Qur'an. The Qur'an refers to two kinds of inspiration from Allah:

- 1) A verbal or literal inspiration by which the actual words of Allah are conveyed in human language (possibly through an angel), and
- 2) Instinctive inspiration by Allah to His creations. This includes a suggestion thrown by Allah into the heart-or mind of a person, by which he/she understands the substance of the message, whether it is a command, a prohibition, or an explanation of a great truth. The first kind of inspiration includes divine revelation.

The Qur'an also uses wahy in reference to covert suggestions by evil ones (from humans and shayateen) - see the figure on page 3.

In this article, examples from the Qur'an are given to the two kinds of inspiration of Allah; as well as the inspiration of the evil ones.

Inspiration to Prophets

This includes verbal, literal inspiration, and revelation given to the prophets. The inspiration given to Prophet Noah (PBUH) is mentioned in Surah 4.


"It is not fitting for any human being that Allah should speak to him unless (it be) by inspiration, or from behind a veil, or by sending of a Messenger to reveal, with Allah's permission, what Allah wills. Verily, He is most High, most Wise."

(Qur'an 42:51)

"We have sent you inspiration, as We sent it to Noah and the Messengers after him: We sent inspiration to Abraham, Isma'il, Isaac, Jacob and the tribes, to Jesus, Job, Jonah, Aaron, and Solomon, and to David We gave the Psalms."

(Qur'an 4:163)

The same verse states the fact that inspiration of the same kind as that sent to Prophet Mohammad (PBUH) was sent to many messengers, for Allah's message is one. Note that the inspiration given to the prophets does not necessarily mean a book. Some

messengers were mentioned by name in the cited verse, others are not mentioned by name. The list of Prophets is divided into three groups: the first group is *Ibrahim's* family (*Ibrahim, Ismail, Isaac, Jacob*); the second group includes *Issa* (Jesus - PBUH), *Ayub* (Job - PBUH), and *Yunus* (Jonah - PBUH); the third group includes *Haroun* (Aaron - PBUH) and Solomon (PBUH), both great figures, but each subordinate to another figure, viz. Moses and David.

The revelation given to Prophet Mohammad (PBUH) was through the angel *Jibreel* (Gabriel). The Prophet (PBUH) used to hear a sound like that of a bell ringing when angel *Jibreel* approached him. The chemistry of his


Instinctive Inspiration by Allah to His Creations

Examples of this kind of inspiration (i.e., suggestion or command) given by Allah to His creatures include inspirations given to Prophets, other human beings, bees, and inanimate

objects. Allah inspired Noah (PBUH) to construct the Ark.

So We inspired him (with this message); "construct the ark within Our sight and under Our guidance."
(Our'an 23:27)

وَاصْنَعِ الْفُلْكَ بِأَعْيُنِنَا وَوَحْيِنَا . (سورة هود - من آية ٣٧)



"But construct an Ark under Our eyes and Our inspiration". (Qur'an 11:37) Allah inspired Prophet Moses to:

 throw his rod and it swallowed up all the falsehood of the sorcerers.

We revealed to Moses "throw your rod": and behold! it swallows up all the falsehoods which they fake!

(Qur'an 7:117)

 strike the rock with his rod, and out of it gushed forth twelve springs

We directed Moses by inspiration, when his (thirsty) people asked him for water "Strike the rock with your staff", out of it there gushed forth twelve springs.

(Qur'an 7:160)

 travel by night with the Israelites, and strike a dry path for them in the sea

We sent an inspiration to Moses: "Travel by night with My servants, and strike a dry path for them through the sea, without fear of being overtaken (by Pharaoh) and without (any other) fear."

(Qur'an 20:77)

وَأَوْحَيْنَاۤ إِلَى مُوسَى أَنْ أَسْرِ بِعِبَادِى إِنَّاكُمُ مُتَّبَعُونَ .

By inspiration We told Moses; "Travel by night with My servants; for surely you shall be pursued."

(Qur'an 26:52)

Then We told Moses by inspiration: "strike the sea with your rod so it divided". (Qur'an 26:63)

 provide dwellings for the Israelites in Egypt.

We inspired Moses and his brother with this message: "Provide dwellings for your people in Egypt".

(Qur'an 10:87)

Examples of inspirations given to other human beings are the inspiration given to the mother of Prophet Moses (PBUH) to throw Moses in the chest and throw the chest into the river.

Behold! We sent to your mother, by inspiration, the message: throw (the child) into chest, and throw (the chest) into the river.

(Qur'an 20:38-39)

So We sent this inspiration to the mother of Moses; "suckle your child, but when you fear for him, then cast him into the river."

(Qur'an 28:7)

And the inspiration given to the disciples of Jesus (PBUH) to have faith in Allah and in Jesus.

وَإِذْ أَوْحَيْثُ إِلَى الْحُوَارِيِّينَ أَنْ ءَامِنُوا بِى وَبِـرَسُولِى قَـالُوا ءَامَنَّا وَاشْهَــدْ بِأَنَّنَا مُسْلِمُونَ .

"And behold! I inspired the disciples to have faith in Me and My messenger: They said: we have faith, and do you bear witness that we bow to Allah as Muslims."

(Qur'an 5:111)

The inspiration to the angels to support the believers in the Battle of Badr, to smite the unbelievers above their necks and to smite all their fingertips off them is mentioned in *Surah* 8:

Remember your Lord inspired the angels (with the message): "I am with you; give firmness to the believers: I will instill terror into the hearts of the unbelievers: smite them over the necks and smite all their finger-tips off them." (Qur'an 8:12)

The inspiration given to the bee to build its cells in hills, on trees, and in human habitation is mentioned in *Surah* 16:

"And your Lord taught the bee to build its cells in hills, on trees, and in what they erect." (Qur'an 16:68)

The inspiration given to each heaven by Allah as to its duty and command, is mentioned in *Surah* 41:

"And He assigned to each heaven its duty and command." (Qur'an 41:12) When the earth is shaken to her utmost convulsion, on that day she will declare that Allah has given her "inspiration".

"For that your Lord will have given her (the Earth) inspiration."

(Our'an 99:5)

Covert suggestions given by evil ones

The inspiration given by the evil ones (shayateen), from the humans and the jinns, includes the flowery discourses aimed at deception, and the arguments aimed at poisoning the minds of the believers. These types of inspiration are mentioned in the following two verses:

وَكَذَلِكَ جَعَلْنَا لِكُلِّ نَبِيٍّ عَدُوًّا شَيَاطِينَ الإنس وَالْجِنِّ يُوحِى بَعْضُهُمْ إِلَى بَعْضٍ زُخْرُفَ الْقَوْلِ غُرُورًا . إِلَى بَعْضٍ زُخْرُفَ الْقَوْلِ غُرُورًا . (سورة الأنعام - من آية 111)

Likewise did We make for every messenger an enemy, satans among humans and jinns, inspiring each other with flowery discourses by way of deception. (Qur'an 6:112)

وَإِنَّ الشَّيَاطِينَ لَيُوحُونَ إِلَى أَوْلِيَآثَهِمْ لِيُجَادِلُوكُمْ . (سورة الأنعام - من آية ١٢١)

"But the satans ever inspire their friends (from humans) to dispute with you." (Qur'an 6:121)

There are some who claim falsely that they received inspiration from Allah. The Qur'an tells us about their condition at the time of death.

And who can be more unjust than one who invents a lie against Allah, or says, "I have received inspiration" when he has received none; and who says"I will reveal the like of what Allah has revealed". And if you could but see when the wicked are in the agonies of death, while the angels are stretching forth their hands (saying),

"Deliver your souls; this day you shall be recompensed with the torment of degradation because of what you used to utter against Allah other than the truth." (Qur'an 6:93)

Example of Allah's inspiration given to sincere believers

Allah's inspiration can be given to sincere believers. The example of *Umar* (may Allah be pleased with him) standing to deliver the sermon, when through the inspiration of Allah, he saw hundreds of miles away the Muslim's army about to be surrounded by their enemy. The only way out for the Muslims was to go towards a hill. *Umar* said to the commander of the Muslims in an audible voice: "Go to the hill, *Sariya*". Again, through the inspiration of Allah, the commander, *Sariya*, heard *Umar*, went to the hill and saved the Muslims.


In a hadith Qudsi we are told that if we perform all the obligatory duties (fara'id) to Allah, and seek the pleasure of Allah by performing, in addition, some of the optional acts of worship (Nawa'fil), then Allah will love us. When Allah loves us, He takes control of our senses, and direct them towards what is most beneficial to us, in both the present world and the one to come.



We pray to Almighty Allah to give us the guidance and the wisdom to benefit from the signs of the Qur'an.



Whenever the Prophet (PBUH) went to bed at night, he used to cup his hands together and blow over them after reciting these Surahs, and then rub his hands over whatever parts of his body he was able to rub, starting with his head, face and front of his body (and repeats that three times).

كان الرسول صلى الله عليه وسلم إذا أوى إلى فراشه كل ليلة جمع كفيه ثم نفث فيهما وقرأ هذه السور ثم يمسح بهما ما إستطاع من جسده يبدأ بهما على رأسه ووجهه وما أقبل من جسده - يفعل ذلك ثلاث مرات

* According to the Muslim scholar Abul A'la Maududi, the religion of Islam, as presented in the Qur'an, is based on three doctrines: *Tauhid* (unity of Godhead), Apostleship, and the Hereafter. *Surah Al-Ikhlas* teaches *Tauhid*, pure and undefiled. Therefore, the Prophet (PBUH) regarded it as equal to one-third of the Qur'an.
