

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Editorial

The recent discovery, by astronomers using new instruments, of galaxies forming at a furious pace much deeper in space (11 billion light years from earth), and far earlier in time, than expected was not publicized enough. It confirmed the conclusion reached by a number of famous astronomers, who spent their professional lifetime coaxing secrets out of the stars, peering through telescopes (see figure on page 3) trying to learn more about the origins and destiny of the universe, that the world is much more complicated than can be explained by science. For those astronomers, recent scientific discoveries, such as the fact that the universe is expanding, offer support for spirituality and hints of the power of God. In this connection, the following facts stated in the Our'an are worth noting

1) The expansion of the universe, which is the most imposing discovery of modern science, is referred to in the Qur'an.

"We have built the firmament with might: and We indeed have the power and the means to extend it and

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
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
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Software for Teaching Salat

Mystery of the Pairs (or Two Sexes)

ر الأزواج

The principle of the pairs, and the existence of all things in the universe in couples, is a realty that we observe day and night, but few of us ponder over it seriously, and fewer understand the signs and pointers it contains. In this article, an attempt is made to explain this principle on the basis of the Qur'an.

Allah (SWT) tells us in the Qur'an, that everything in the world has been created in accordance with the principle of the pairs (see Qur'an 51:49). The whole system of the universe, as created by Allah (SWT), is functioning in accordance with the principle that certain things are either counterparts, or complementary and matching to certain others; and their combinations brings into being countless new forms and combinations. Nothing, except Allah (SWT), is so unique as may have no match.

Pairs among Living Creations

The mystery of the pairs (or the two sexes) runs through all the living creations of Allah as described subsequently. All human beings are created from a single pair of parents:

"O ye people! We have created you from a single (pair) of a male and a female, and made you into nations and tribes that you may know one another." (Qur'an 49:13) In human beings and animals, Allah (SWT) refers to the males and females in several verses, for example,

بِسمِ اللهِ الرَّحْمنِ الرَّحِيمِ
وَمِن كُلِّ شَـن وَ خَلَفْنَا زَوْجَيْنِ لَعَلَّكُمْ تَذَكَّرُونَ .
(سورة الذاريات - آية ٤٩)

"And of everything We have created pairs: that you may remember (the Grace of Allah)" (Qur'an 51:49)

"And that He (Allah) creates the pairs - male and female". (Qur'an 53:45)

(سورة القيامة - آية ٣٩)

"And of him/her He made two sexes - male and female." (Qur'an 75:39)



And We have created you in pairs.
(Qur'an 78:8)

"And by Him who Created male and female." (Qur'an 92:3)

The creation of human beings in pairs (Qur'an 78:8) does not only refer to male and female, but to opposite characteristics such as tall and short, good and bad,..etc.

In both humans and animals, the coming together of the male and female is the cause of procreation. The same law applies to vegetation.

"And of the fruit of every kind He

made pairs, two and two."
(Qur'an 13:3)

"He has sent down water (rain) from the sky. Within have We produced diverse pairs of plants each separate from the others." (Qur'an 20:53)

"We send down water (rain) from the sky, and produce on the earth every kind of noble creature, in pairs." (Qur'an 31:10)

وَالأَرْضَ مَدَدْنَاهَا وَأَلْقَیْنَا فِیهَا رَوَاسِیَ وَأُنبَتْنَا فِیهَا مِن کُلِّ رَوَاسِیَ وَأُنبَتْنَا فِیهَا مِن کُلِّ زَوْجٍ بَهِیجٍ • (سهرة ق - آبة ۷)

"And the earth - We have spread it out, and set thereon mountains standing firm, and produced therein every kind of beautiful growth (in pairs)."

(Qur'an 50:7)

Allah created the plants with their productive apparatus - like animals - male stamens and female pistils. Allah send the winds to put the pollen of the male tree on to the ovaries of the female tree.

"And We send the impregnating winds." (Qur'an 15:22)

Also, the clouds as vapor are manipulated by the winds, which set up atmospheric currents resulting in condensation and the descent of rain.

Pairs among Lifeless Creations

Even the lifeless (in human terms inanimate) and the forces of nature are created in pairs. Notice the word "thing" in the Qur'an 51:49, cited at the beginning of the article. Many examples of the inanimate pairs can be cited. The positive and negative electricity. The atom itself has positively charged protons in its nucleus, and negatively charged electrons revolving around the nucleus. The close affinity between the positive and negative electric charges results in wonderful things. The night and the day are pairs of opposites created by Allah (SWT):

"It is He (Allah) who created the night and the day." (Qur'an 21:33)
Allah created the night and the day for the benefit of humans, and possibly, other creations. The night provides rest, while the day promotes activity.

The evil and the good are a pair of opposites. Their presence is important for our worldly life:

2) The more a person is aware, conscious and knowledgeable of the power, and other attributes, of Allah, the more he/she will fear His disobedience.

"And We test you by evil and by good, by way of trial." (Qur'an 21:35)
The presence of evil makes the person discover his/her weakness and his/her strengths. The wise person strengthen his/her communication with the true source of power, Allah (SWT), to overcome his/her weakness.

Even the numbers are divided into even and odd. It is Allah (SWT) who created all the pairs:

"That has created pairs in all things," (Qur'an 43:12)

The pairs that Allah (SWT) created include the earth's produce, mankind, and other creations that we have no knowledge about:

سُبْحَانَ الَّذِى خَلَقَ الأَزْوَاجَ كُلُهَا مِثَا تُنبِتُ الأَزْضُ وَمِنْ كُلُهَا مِثَا لاَ يَعْلَمُونَ. أَنفُسِهِمْ وَمِثَا لاَ يَعْلَمُونَ. أَنفُسِهِمْ وَمِثَا لاَ يَعْلَمُونَ. (سورة يس - آية ٣٦)

Glory be to Allah who created in pairs

"Those truly fear Allah, among His servants who have knowledge."

(Our'an 35:28)

3) Despite the recent discoveries, our knowledge about the universe, and about our own selves is very limited.

"Of knowledge it is only a little that is communicated to you."

(Qur'an 17:85)

4) We are repeatedly encouraged in the Qur'an to reflect and ponder on the wonderful administration of the heavens and the earth, so that we can come to the conclusion that every particle of Allah's creation is a clear evidence of the truth of the Divine message relayed to us in all things that the earth produces, as well as their own (human) kind and other things of which they have no knowledge." (Qur'an 36:36)

Signs and Pointers Contained in the Principle of Pairs


- The principle of the pairs contains in itself such complexities and finesses of wisdom and workmanship, and the mutual relationships between the members of each pair can neither be the result of an accident, or the creations of many gods. Rather it is a strong demonstration that the creator is One and only One.
- The reality of the pairs testifies expressly to the necessity of the hereafter as the match and partner of the present life. Without partner, the present worldly life would be absolutely fruitless.

I pray to Almighty Allah to give us the strength to use our faculties in enhancing our appreciation of the signs and pointers given to us in the Qur'an.

Supplications of the Traveler أدعية المسافر

Bidding farewell to one's relatives and friends توديع الأهل والأقارب

The traveler should say:

أستودعكم الله الذي لا تضيع و دائعه

"I commend you to Allah Whose trusts are never lost."

The relatives, and friends say to the traveler:

أستودع الله دينك ، وأمانتك ، وخواتيم عملك .

"To Allah I commend your deen (Islam), your trust, and the conclusion of your deeds."

زودك الله التقوى ، و غفر ذنبك ويسر لك الخير حيثما كنت

"May Allah provide you with piety, forgive your sins, and facilitate the good for you wherever you are."

اللهم اطو له البعد وهون عليه

"O Allah! make the distance short for him and make his journey easy for him."

When leaving home ما يقوله المسافر عند الحروج

"In the name of Allah, I repose my trust in Allah, and there is neither power nor any might except with Allah. O Allah! I seek refuge with You from leading others astray or being led astray, causing others to slip or being caused to slip by others, or doing wrong or be wronged by others, or behaving foolishly or being treated foolishly by others."

O Allah, we seek virtue and piety from You on this journey of ours, and actions that please You. O Allah lighten this journey of ours, and make its distance easy for us. O Allah, You are (our) companion during the journey, and guardian of (our) family. O Allah, I seek refuge with You from the hardship of the journey, the gloominess of the sights, and from finding misfortunes in property and family on our return

On riding (a car or a plane) ما يقوله المسافر عند الركوب

The traveler should say:

بسم الله - سبحان الذي سخر لنا هذا وما كنا له مقرنين ، وإنا إلى ربنا لمنقلبون

"In the name of Allah. Glory be to Him who has subjected this (means of transportation) to our (use), for we could never have accomplished this (by ourselves). And to our Lord, surely, we are going to return."

الحمد لله (ثلاثا) والله أكبر ثلاثا

"Praise be to Allah (three times) . Allah is the Greatest (three times)."

سبحانك لاإله إلا أنت قد ظلمت نفسي فأغفر لي ، إنه لا يغفر الذنوب إلا أنت

"Glory to You (O Allah), there is no god but You, I have indeed wronged my soul, so forgive me verily none can forgive sins except You."

When the traveler stops at a place on the way he/she should say:

أعوذ بكلمات الله التامات كلها من شر

"I seek refuge with all the perfect words of Allah from the evil of his creatures."

Supplications of the Traveler (continued) أدعية المسافر – تكملة

At nightfall ما يقوله المسافر إذا أدركه الليل

يا أرض ، ربِّي وربك الله ، أعوذ بالله من شرك ، وشر ما فيك ، وشر ما خُلق فيك، وشر ما دب عليك ، أعوذ بالله من شركل أسد وأسود، وحيَّة وعقرَب، وشر ساكن البلد، وشر والد وما وكد

"O earth, my Lord and your Lord is Allah. I seek refuge in Allah from your evil, the evil of what you contain, the evil of what has been created in you, and the evil of what creeps upon you. I seek refuge in Allah from lions, from large black snakes, from other snakes, from scorpions, from the evil of jinn who inhabit settlements, and from a parent and his offspring."

I ask You of the good of this village, the good of its people and the good it has, and seek Your protection from its evil, and the evil of its people, and the evil in it."

"O Allah! bless us in it (three times)", and "O Allah grant us sustenance from its fruits, and put our love in (the hearts of) its people, and put the love of its righteous people in our hearts."

I ask You of the good in it, and the good of what You have placed in it, and I seek Your refuge from its evil and the evil of what You have placed in it" "O Allah! give us its fruits and protect us from its plagues, and put our love in the hearts of its people and put the love of its righteous people in our hearts.

At dawn ما يقوله وقت السحر

سمَّع سامِعٌ بحمد الله وحُسن بلائه علينا ، رَبُّنا صَاحِبْنا وأفضل علينا ، عَائِذًا بالله من النار

"A listener has heard that we praise Allah for His favors upon us. Our Lord, accompany us and grants us Your favors. We seek protection of Allah from the fire."

When approaching a difficult path or while returning

"There is no god but Allah, He is One. He has no partners. To Him belongs all dominion and praise, and He has power over all things. We are returning repentant, worshipping, prostrating, praising our Lord. He kept His promise and gave victory to His servant. and defeated all the confederates alone."

Characteristics of Prophet *Ibrahim* (Abraham) as described in the Qur'an وصف القرآن لصفات و فضل إبراهيم عليه السلام

Prophet *Ibrahim* is distinguished in Muslim theology with the title *Khalilu Allah* (friend of Allah). His faith was pure and true, and his conduct was firm and righteous in all circumstances. He was the fountainhead of the present monotheistic tradition, the patriarch of the prophetic line, and is revered alike by Jews, Christians, and Muslims.

True and sound in Faith, and one who bowed his will to Allah (Qur'an 3:67)
